Oaks T11 and T12 which are growing in the back garden. The proposed works are to crown reduce both trees by 5 to 6 metres back to previous pruning points.

TPO/107/2/G T1- English Oak (rear garden) - Reduce lateral canopy by approximately 2m, and tops by approximately 3m to appropriate growth points, following BS3998 standards, utilising drop-crotch pruning methods to reduce stress and epicormic growth. Thin canopy by 30% to allow more light through the canopy, whilst still retaining some internal epicormic growth to help minimise stress and to follow appropriate tree pruning guidance. South West lowest branch to be reduced by approximately 3.5m to the woodpecker hole to help neaten the crown shape and reduce loading after a woodpecker hole. The aim of the reduction is to keep the tree managed before it becomes too big for its location and needs a more drastic reduction in the future.

TPO/107/3/F. Felling of beech tree to ground level -The tree has visible Ganoderma fungal brackets at the base, indicating significant decay and potential structural weakness. This presents a risk of failure and potential harm to nearby property and persons. Removal is proposed on safety grounds.
