The Bookhams Residents Association strongly supports this nomination. This land has been in community use since the whole area of the Garstons, Mead Crescent, Stone Hill Close and Vicarage Close was developed in the 1950s as a large estate.

The land provides a pathway into the Barn Hall Field used by many for recreation purposes and is also used by MVDC vehicles for maintenance of this Field. Additionally, the access provided is essential for Bookham Village Day which some hundreds of Bookham villagers attend. Without access this significant annual event cannot proceed as it represents one of three essential safety exit routes demanded under H & S regulations
